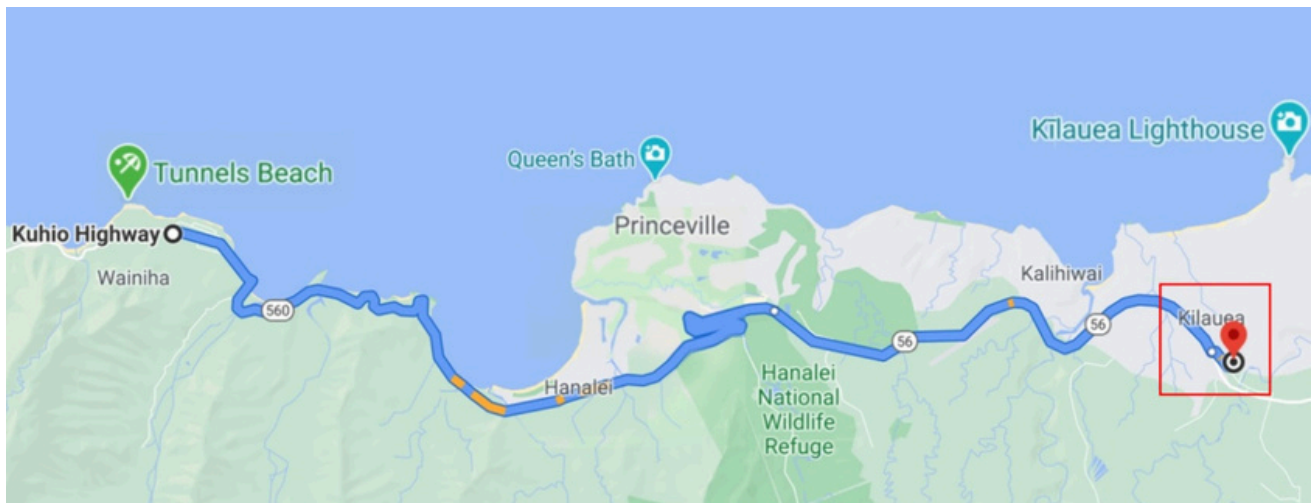

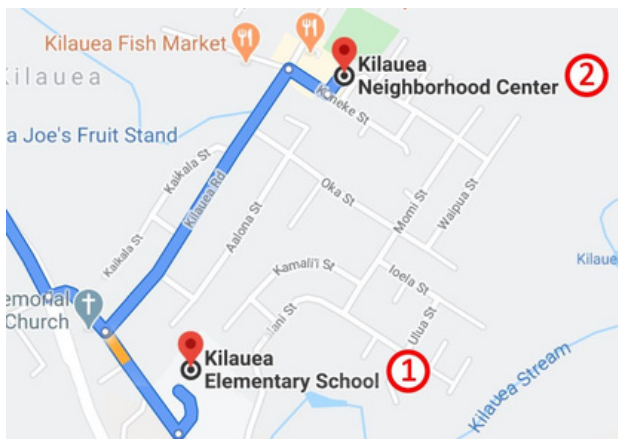

## North Shore Evacuation Shelters:

**1.Evacuation Shelter:** 5-6957-B Kuhio Hwy to Kilauea Elementary School, 2440 Kolo Rd. Kilauea, HI 96754 Head East on Kuhio highway for 11 miles. Turn left on Kolo Rd (.3 mi), Turn left. School is on the Right.



**2. Evacuation Shelter:** 5-6957-B Kuhio Hwy to Kilauea Neighborhood Center, 4260 Keneke St, Kilauea, HI 96754. Head East on Kuhio highway for 11 miles. Turn left on Kolo Rd (.1 mi), Turn left on Kilauea Rd (.4 mi). Turn Right onto Keneke St. School (320 ft.) Turn Left and then slight right to Destination on the left.



## What to do when evacuating:

1. Gather water, food, clothing, emergency supplies, and insurance/ financial records
2. Wear protective clothing and sturdy shoes.
3. Secure your home.
4. Turn off the main water valve, electricity, and propane tank if instructed to do so.
5. Let others know where you are going.
6. Leave early enough to avoid being trapped by severe weather.
7. Follow recommended evacuation routes.
